



## KAYAKING: SUNSET PADDLE w/LIGHTS EATS & DRINKS - 2025

### Price / Season / Reservations

**Price:** 1 person = \$180, 2 people = \$145 per person, 3 people = \$135 pp, 4 people = \$125 pp, 5-6 people = \$110 pp, 7-11 people = \$100 pp. Includes guide, kayak, paddle, PFD, waterproof lap blanket, light eats (vegan and gluten free options), beer, wine and non-alcoholic beverages. Minimum age 2. Groups of 12 or more get a 20% discount.

**Season:** All year.

### Meeting Place / Time

**Place:** State Park Marina, 10 State Park Road, Morro Bay, CA.

**Time:** Usually about 2.5 hours before sunset. See our website at [www.centralcoastoutdoors.com](http://www.centralcoastoutdoors.com) for details.

**Approximate Tour Time:** 3-3.5 hours. Average paddle time is 2-2.5 hours.

### Itinerary

Morro Bay at dusk is a different world. Slowly the human activity of the daylight hours fades away and the rhythms of the natural world reassert themselves. Wildlife can seem even more accessible as other recreational users of the bay leave the water. It's truly a magical time to be on the bay. This private sunset guided kayak tour of Morro Bay begins about two and a half hours before sunset and finishes back at the kayak docks a bit after dusk, as the last of the natural light fades and the lights of the harbor and town start winking on. Our very casual route meanders through the bay and includes a visit to the dunes of the sand spit. Nestled into the dunes with a complimentary drink (wine, beer or soda) in hand along with cheese, crackers and fruit, you'll watch the last lingering rays of light as the day ends. On foggy days, the sunset won't be as spectacular, but the sense of peace on the water as daylight fades is possibly even more dramatic.

### Climate / Weather

The climate along the coast in Morro Bay is temperate year round, with daily high temperatures rarely exceeding the mid 50s to mid 70s range with most days having highs somewhere in the 60s. Spring days are often breezy and in summer there is often fog for at least part of the day. Fall tends to have the warmest and clearest weather. In winter we may encounter rain, but a significant number of winter days on the bay feature calm conditions and crystal clear air. After sunset, temperatures can drop rapidly.
