

KAYAKING: SUNSET PADDLE - TWO HOUR - 2025

Price / Season / Reservations

Price: 1 person = \$140, 2 people = \$110 per person, 3 people = \$100 pp, 4 people = \$90 pp, 5-6 people = \$80 pp, 7-11 people = \$70 pp. Youths age 5-12 get a 20% discount (minimum age is 5). Groups of 12+ = \$56 flat rate

Includes: Guide, kayak, paddles, PFDs, waterproof fleece lined lap blanket, snacks, water.

Season: All year.

Itinerary

Morro Bay at dusk is a magical time to be on the water. This short version of our private sunset paddle series starts a bit later than our other sunset paddles and stays exclusively on the water. Our exact route is dependent on tides, weather conditions and recent wildlife activity. We might visit a seal haul out area, an oyster farm and/or the heron preserve. It's always possible to sea otters as well. We'll pause on the water to say goodbye to the sun before returning to the docks. On foggy days, the sunset won't be as spectacular, but the sense of peace on the water as daylight fades is possibly even more dramatic.

Climate / Weather

The climate along the coast in Morro Bay is temperate year round, with daily high temperatures rarely exceeding the mid 50s to mid 70s range with most days having highs somewhere in the 60s. Spring days are often breezy and in summer there is often fog for at least part of the day. Fall tends to have the warmest and clearest weather. In winter we may encounter rain, but a significant number of winter days on the bay feature calm conditions and crystal clear air. After sunset, temperatures can drop rapidly.
