



KAYAKING: DINNER ON THE DUNES - 2021

Price / Season / Reservations

Price: Groups of 2-3 = \$150 per person, groups of 4-6 = \$130 per person, groups of 7-9 = \$110 per person groups of 10+ = \$95 per person. Youth discounts (10%-75%) vary with age. Includes kayak rental, snacks, water and dinner.

Season: Best from mid March to early November, but can be done in winter as well.

Meeting Place / Time

Place: State Park Marina, 10 State Park Road, Morro Bay, CA.

Time: Usually about 2.5 hours before sunset. Call us for details.

Approximate Tour Time: 3-3.5 hours. Total paddle time is about 1.5-2 hours.

Itinerary

Our Dinner on the Dunes trip is possibly one of the most unique kayak trips in California. Kayaking Morro Bay in the late afternoon, we'll visit some of the favorite hangout areas for local wildlife before heading to the outer sandspit. Beaching on the far side of the bay, you'll have a chance to frolic in the pristine sand dunes while your guide prepares a delicious [California beach style grilled dinner](#), including complimentary locally produced wines and beers and a selection of sodas, juices and bottled waters. As the sun slowly slips behind the dunes, you'll climb back in your kayak for a magical paddle in the deepening dusk back to the docks - an experience you will not soon forget!

Climate / Weather

The climate along the coast in Morro Bay is temperate year round, with daily high temperatures rarely exceeding the mid 50s to mid 70s range with most days having highs somewhere in the 60s. Spring days are often breezy and in summer there is often fog for at least part of the day. Fall tends to have the warmest and clearest weather. In winter we may encounter rain, but a significant number of winter days on the bay feature calm conditions and crystal clear air. After sunset, temperatures can drop rapidly.
