



KAYAKING: MORRO BAY HALF DAY CLASSIC w/LUNCH – 2025

Price / Season / Reservations

Price: 2 people = \$165 per person, 3 people = \$150 pp, 4 people = \$140 pp, 5-6 people = \$130 pp, 7-11 people = \$120 pp. Youths age 5-12 get a 20% discount. Youths age 2-4 get a 50% discount (minimum age is 2). Groups of 12+ = \$100 flat rate. Includes guide, kayak, paddles, PFDs, snacks, water and gourmet picnic lunch.

Season: All year.

Meeting Place / Time

Place: State Park Marina, 10 State Park Road, Morro Bay, CA.

Time: Usually 9:00 am, but can meet later on request. Might meet earlier on windy days.

Approximate Tour Time: 4-4.5 hours. Average time on water 2-2.5 hours. Average time on dunes 1-1.5 hours.

Itinerary

Kayaking through the wildlife filled waters of Morro Bay in the morning and then having a [gourmet picnic lunch](#) on the pristine sand dunes at mid day is truly a memorable experience. After launching, our exact kayaking route may vary depending on tides and recent wildlife activity on the bay, but includes possible visits to a seal haul out area, a heron rookery, and an oyster farm as well as chances to see otters. Later in the morning, we beach our kayaks on a secluded part of the sand dunes. Digging your toes in the sand, you can simply enjoy this magical environment or opt for a short climb over the dunes to stunning ocean views up and down miles of isolated beach. Back on the bay side of the dunes, you'll linger a while longer for a [gourmet picnic lunch](#). The short paddle across Morro Bay back to the docks rounds out this highly rewarding kayak tour. This trip is an excellent choice for all paddlers, including beginners and family groups.

Climate / Weather

The climate along the coast in Morro Bay is temperate year round, with daily high temperatures rarely exceeding the mid 50s to mid 70s range with most days having highs somewhere in the 60s. Spring days are often breezy and in summer there is often fog for at least part of the day. Fall tends to have the warmest and clearest weather. In winter we may encounter rain, but a significant number of winter days on the bay feature calm conditions and crystal clear air.



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
