Price / Season / Reservations

Price: 1 person = \$135, 2 people = \$105 per person, 3 people = \$95 pp, 4 people = \$85 pp, 5-6 people = \$75 pp,

7-9 people = \$65 pp. Youths age 12 and under get 20% discount. Groups of 10+=\$64 flat rate

Meeting Place / Time

Place: State Park Marina, 10 State Park Road, Morro Bay, CA.

Time: Variable. Might meet earlier on windy days.

Approximate Total Tour Time: 2-2.5 hours. Average paddle time is 1.5-2 hours

Itinerary

Our private two hour kayak tour is an action packed guided tour designed to optimize your time on the wildlife rich waters of Morro Bay National Estuary, which is protected from the open ocean by a four mile long sand spit. On this private kayak tour you can concentrate your time on the water or split time between being on the water and on the dunes (kids love the dunes!). On the water, our exact kayaking route may vary depending on tides and recent wildlife activity on the bay, but includes possible visits to a seal haul out area, a heron rookery, and an oyster farm. If you work in a stop at the dunes, you can simply relax with your toes in the sand of this magical environment or you take a short climb over the top of the dunes with your guide to stunning ocean views up and down miles of isolated beach. If you visit the dunes, time on the water will be more limited, but no matter which option you choose, there are always chances to see otters. Great trip for families!

Climate / Weather

The climate along the coast in Morro Bay is temperate year round, with daily high temperatures rarely exceeding the mid 50s to mid 70s range with most days having highs somewhere in the 60s. Spring days are often breezy and in summer there is often fog for at least part of the day. Fall tends to have the warmest and clearest weather. In winter we may encounter rain, but a significant number of winter days on the bay feature calm conditions and crystal clear air.



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
