



## KAYAKING: PRIVATE TWO HOUR TOUR

### Price / Season / Reservations

**Price:** 1 person = \$140, 2 people = \$110 per person, 3 people = \$100 pp, 4 people = \$90 pp, 5-6 people = \$80 pp, 7-11 people = \$70 pp. Youths age 5-12 get a 20% discount. Youths age 2-4 get a 50% discount (minimum age is 2). Groups of 12+ = \$56 flat rate

**Includes:** Guide, kayak, paddles, PFDs, waterproof fleece lined lap blanket, snacks, water.

**Season:** All year.

### Meeting Place / Time

**Place:** State Park Marina, 10 State Park Road, Morro Bay, CA.

**Time:** Variable. Might meet earlier on windy days.

**Approx Total Tour Time:** 2-2.5 hours. Average on water time is 1.5-2 hours. Optional dunes visit is 0-0.5 hours

### Itinerary

Our private two hour kayak tour is an action packed guided tour designed to optimize your time on the wildlife rich waters of scenic Morro Bay National Estuary, which is protected from the open ocean by a four mile long sand spit. On the water, our exact kayaking route may vary depending on tides and recent wildlife activity on the bay, but includes possible visits to a seal haul out area, a heron rookery, and an oyster farm. There are always chances to see otters as well! While it is possible (with small groups only) to work in a very quick visit to the dunes on the two hour private tour (kids love the dunes!), it usually means lessening the number of places we visit on the water. If you prefer to experience both the watery bay habitat and the dunes more in depth, we highly recommend our [three hour private tour](#). This is a great trip for families!

### Climate / Weather

The climate along the coast in Morro Bay is temperate year round, with daily high temperatures rarely exceeding the mid 50s to mid 70s range with most days having highs somewhere in the 60s. Spring days are often breezy and in summer there is often fog for at least part of the day. Fall tends to have the warmest and clearest weather. In winter we may encounter rain, but a significant number of winter days on the bay feature calm conditions and crystal clear air.
