



## KAYAKING: SUNSET PADDLE - THREE HOUR

### Price / Season / Reservations

**Price:** 1 person = \$170, 2 people = \$130 per person, 3 people = \$115 pp, 4 people = \$105 pp, 5-6 people = \$95 pp, 7-11 people = \$85 pp. Youths age 5-12 get a 20% discount (minimum age is 5). Groups of 12+ = \$64 flat rate.

**Includes:** Guide, kayak, paddles, PFDs, waterproof fleece lined lap blanket, snacks, water.

**Season:** All year.

### Meeting Place / Time

**Place:** State Park Marina, 10 State Park Road, Morro Bay, CA.

**Time:** Usually about 2.5 hours before sunset. See our website at [www.centralcoastoutdoors.com](http://www.centralcoastoutdoors.com) or call us for details.

**Approximate Total Tour Time:** 3-3.5 hours. Average time on water is 2-2.5 hours. Average time on dunes is 30-60 minutes.

### Itinerary

The waters and the dunes of Morro Bay at dusk are a magical places. As sunset approaches, explorers of the bay and dunes are rewarded with a feeling of quietude that is often hard to replicate earlier in the day. Our exact route on the water for this private tour is dependent on tides, weather conditions and recent wildlife activity. We might visit a seal haul out area, an oyster farm and/or the heron preserve. It's always possible to see otters as well. Later in the tour we'll explore the sandspit, pausing at the crest of the dunes to say goodbye to the sun before returning to the docks. On foggy days, the sunset won't be as spectacular, but the sense of peace on the water as daylight fades is possibly even more dramatic.

### Climate / Weather

The climate along the coast in Morro Bay is temperate year round, with daily high temperatures rarely exceeding the mid 50s to mid 70s range with most days having highs somewhere in the 60s. Spring days are often breezy and in summer there is often fog for at least part of the day. Fall tends to have the warmest and clearest weather. In winter we may encounter rain, but a significant number of winter days on the bay feature calm conditions and crystal clear air. After sunset, temperatures can drop rapidly.
